ever.

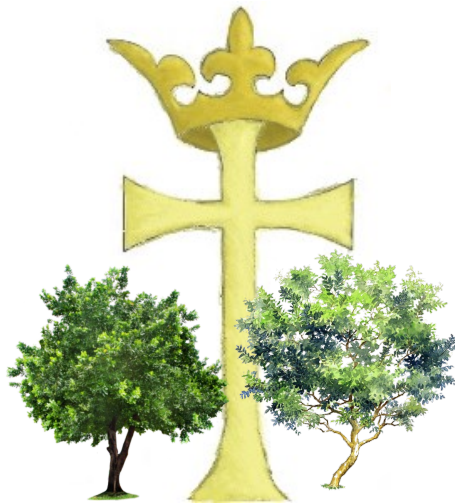
